The National Parks and Wildlife Service of the Department of the Environment, Heritage & Local Government is looking for enthusiastic people to join the dedicated team presently managing Wicklow Mountains National Park and Knocksink Wood Nature Reserve.

Duties will include development and delivery of nature education programmes to a wide-ranging audience with the focus on school groups and provision of an information service. A qualification in Natural Science, previous guiding experience and an interest in Natural Heritage would be advantageous.

These are temporary positions for three months from October 2010 to December 2010.

Work location will be at the Education Centre, Upper Lake, Glendalough, Co. Wicklow and at Knocksink Wood Nature Reserve. The salary of an Education Guide starts at €421.91 per week before tax. **A full, clean driver's licence is essential.**

The appointees will be chosen by competitive interview. A panel of suitable candidates may also be formed should any additional vacancies arise in the foreseeable future.
