



The Geography of Glendalough: Map Skills

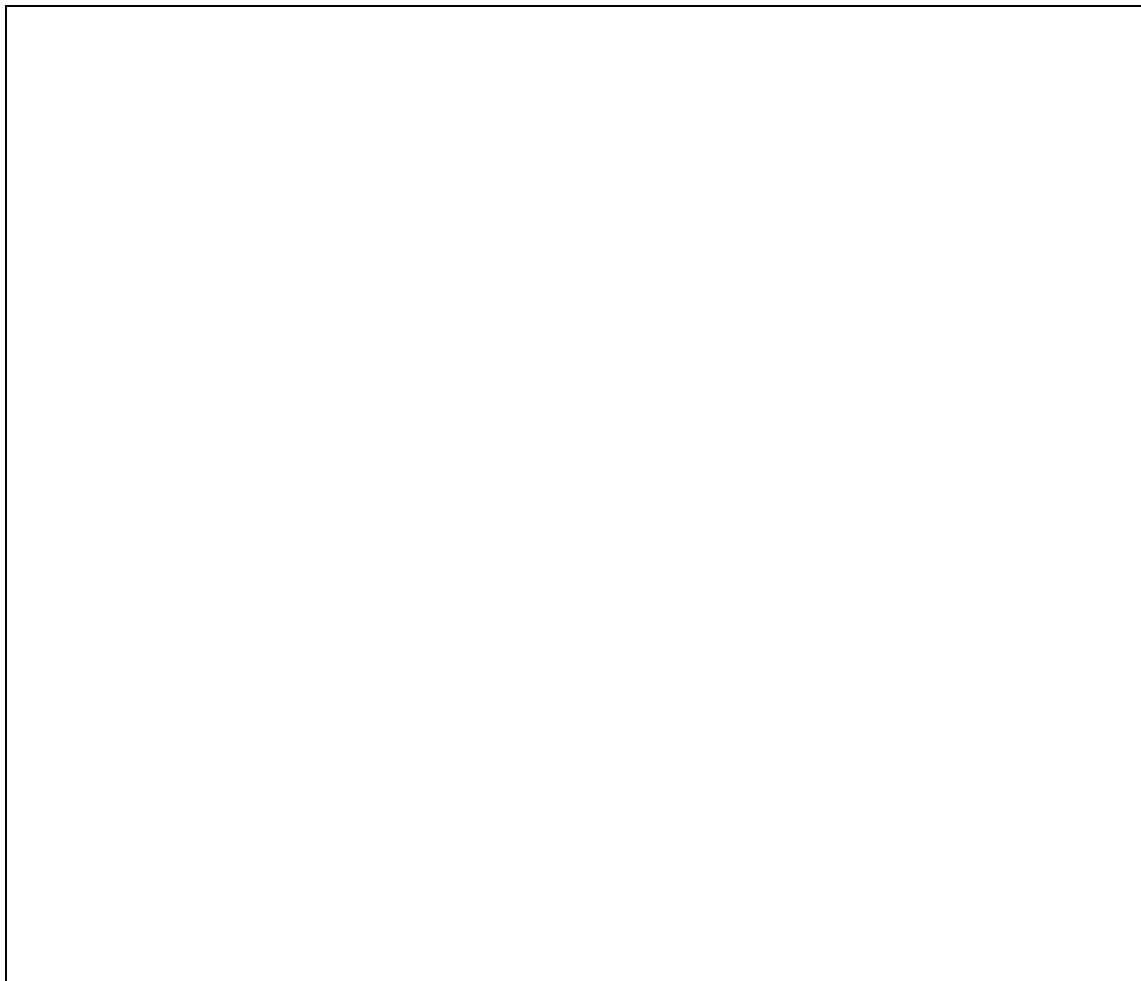
